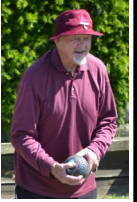
# Practice Makes Perfect!

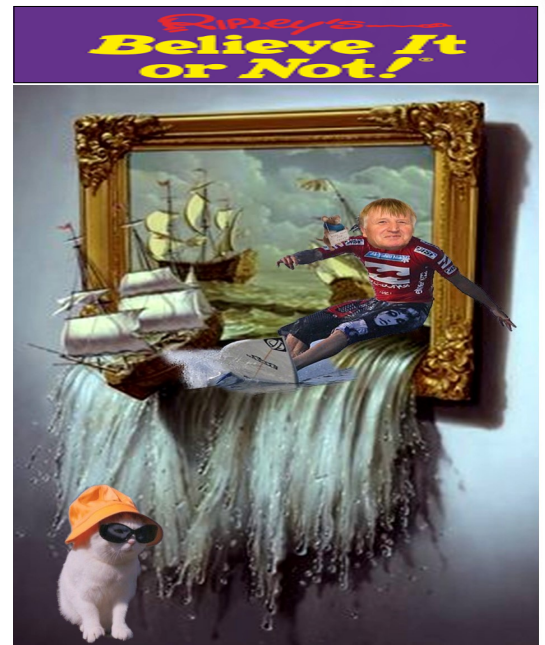
