



Side Captains** and Duty Rinks*

When the teams for each week are put on the selectors board we ask all Side Captains and Duty Rinks to make sure they fulfill your duties.

If you are a new bowler please ask for directions and obtain a list of duties from the secretary.

All players are ask to respect the selector's choices, particularly for the first couple of games.

*Duty rinks are responsible for putting out mats & kitties, paper cups at the water fountains, making sure all score boards are in right position.

** Side Captains should have a copy of the BTS Side Captain's Guide and BTS Conditions of Play 2023-24 (Amended). Also in your kit a couple of bowls stickers etc. just in case. Please know the ruling on practice before games- 3.7 Practice. Meet with the opposition Side Captain to complete the score cards. Record final scores via the computer to BTS.

If an umpire is not available make the best of any measurers present. In welcoming all bowlers for your division point out toilets, whether there is a break or not, smoking rules, who won the toss and name the umpire if present.
