



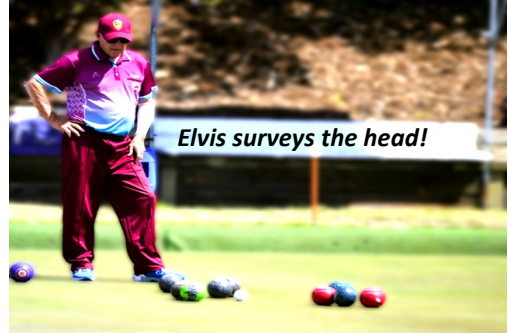

In the windy conditions outside both div 2 & 4 had problems. Div 2 was very unlucky to go down by one 'son of a gun' shot!

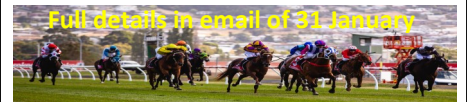
